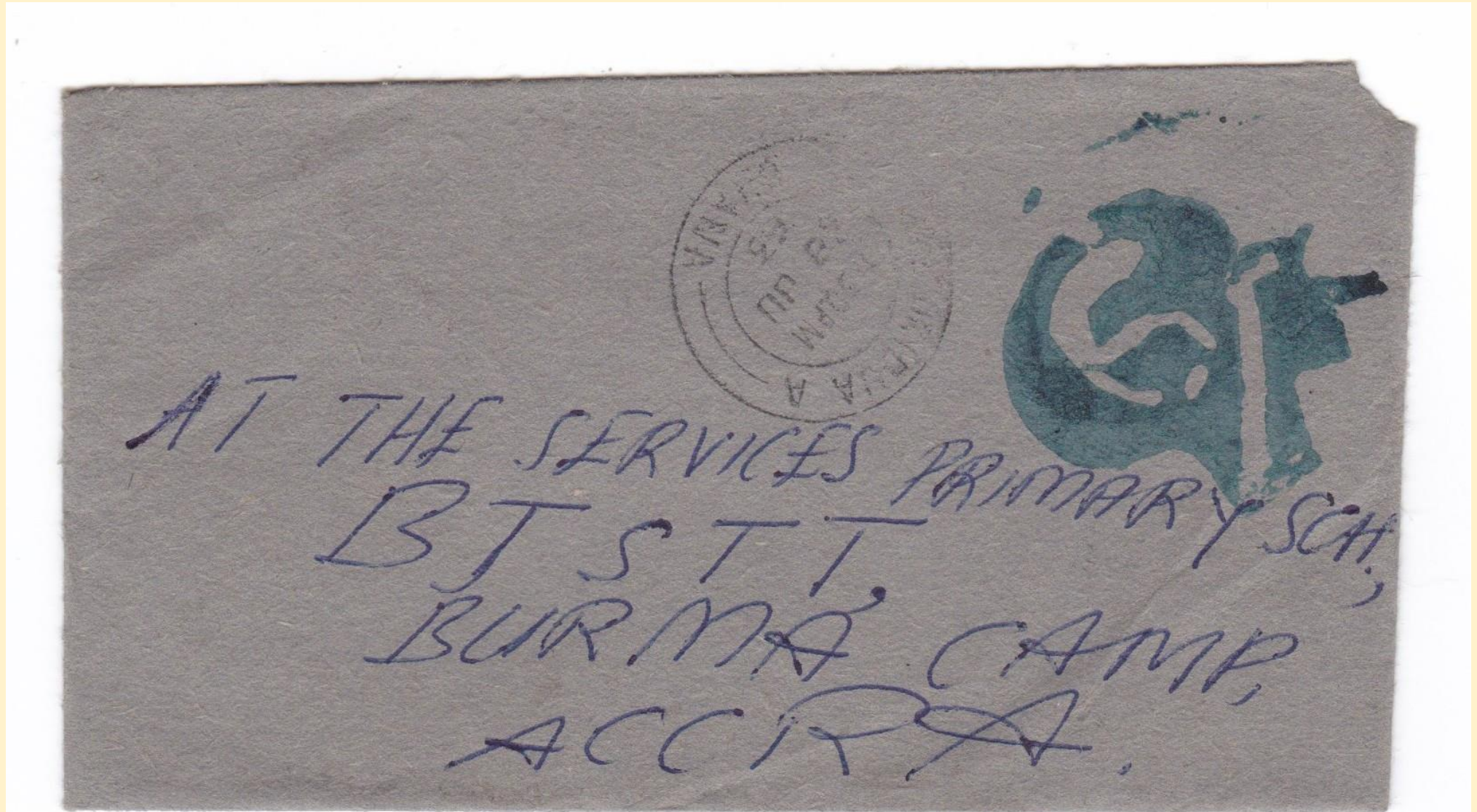


Ghana Cash on Delivery
